

Welcome to Chiswick

Chiswick is a hugely popular and prosperous suburb of West London located on the northern side of the River Thames, a little less than one and a half miles west of Hammersmith.

Chiswick was historically an ancient parish in the county of Middlesex, with an agrarian and fishing economy. Bedford Park, one of the most popular parts of Chiswick, is London's first garden suburb and was built between 1875 and 1886 as part of the Arts & Crafts revival by Victorian property developer Jonathan Carr and his lead architect Richard Norman Shaw.

Chiswick now offers excellent amenities as well as access to some of the prettiest parts of the Thames riverbank, lined with beautiful Georgian properties. There are many exciting restaurants and shops, a thriving cafe culture, numerous prestigious schools, and access to Chiswick Overground station and the District Line. Chiswick is a fantastic place to live with its diverse shops and ever expanding range of delis, along with the green open spaces and superb access to the countryside and beyond.

Chiswick has much to offer when it comes to food and drink, whether it be Michelin-starred dining at Hedone or La Trompette, historic pubs by the river along Strand on the Green and Chiswick Mall, or the café culture along Chiswick High Road.

Hedone

Hedone is a Michelin-starred restaurant with no fixed menu using only the finest and freshest ingredients.

High Road Brasserie

Part of Soho House Group, High Road Brasserie serves some of the best brunch in Chiswick as well as dinner and wines.

Annie's Restaurant

Annie's Restaurant is nestled in Grove Park and offers locally-renowned Mediterranean and British food in a friendly convivial atmosphere.

Charlotte's W4

Perfectly central on Turnham Green Terrace, Charlotte's W4 offers superb dining and a refined and imaginative cocktail bar.

Schools

Chiswick offers excellent schools for all ages, including Falcons School for Boys, Belmont Primary School and Latymer Upper School. Chiswick is also home to the prestigious Arts Education School with alumni including Julie Andrews, Martin Clunes and Will Young.

Belmont Primary School

Situated in the heart of Chiswick, Belmont Primary school has around 420 pupils ranging from 4 to 11 years old.

Latymer Upper School

Latymer is London's leading coeducational school boasting excellent exam results as well as excelling in sports, music and drama.

Orchard House School

Opened in 1993, Orchard House School is a small coeducational prep school based in Bedford Park.

The Falcons School for Boys

The Falcons School for Boys is an all-boys prep school with pre-prep premises in Chiswick and a prep school in Richmond.



Places to visit Some of our favourite local sights

Chiswick offers a rich history from the Norman Shaw designed houses in Bedford Park to Chiswick House and Grounds, once home to Lord Burlington. Sitting on the banks of the River Thames are some stunning Georgian architecture as well as striking modern houses.

The Old Cinema

The Old Cinema is hidden away on Chiswick High Road and provides antique vintage retro collections.

Chiswick House and Grounds

Lord Burlington's Chiswick House is a picturesque, 18th-century Palladian mansion with gardens designed by William Kent.

Theatre at the Tabard

The Tabard Theatre is an intimate 96 seat theatre, with performances ranging from well known comedians to emerging playwrights.

River Thames

Chiswick sits on some of the most beautiful parts of the River Thames with quaint pubs and spectacular Georgian houses.

Chiswick boasts 12 English Heritage blue plaques including Sir Alan Herbert APH and acclaimed writer and novelist Patrick Hamilton.

High Road House is a subsidiary of Soho House which has rooms as well as a highly regarded restaurant and bar.

Chiswick is renowned for its café culture. Particularly notable cafés are TAMP, Nikkis Bakery and delicatessen Hack and Veldt serving Monmouth coffee.

Fullers Griffin Brewery, with its iconic chimney, sits on the banks of the river and produces every drop of Fullers beer served around the world, including the famous London Pride.
