Welcome to St John's Wood


St John's Wood is utterly unique in its setting. Set between the bustle of Central London and Camden, the serenity of Little Venice and the magnificence of Regent's Park, it is idyllically positioned and is one of the very best postcodes in London. It enjoys a vast array of property, from Victorian villas and Nash terraces, to charming mews houses, mansion blocks and modern developments. Named after the Knights of the Order of St John, St John's Wood was declared a conservation area in the 1960s and is celebrated for its diverse range of people; bohemians and artists who were ubiquitous and renowned in the 19th century, the Middle Eastern, Asian and Jewish communities, and the increasing number of American families.
