

Figure 1 - Savills Tech Cities 2017 overall rankings:

grown start-ups and incubators, and are at the top of global shopping lists for tech companies looking for space in which to locate.

The 'wellness' component of the 'buzz and wellness index' examines factors such as the health of the urban environment, including pollution levels, quality of parks, crime rates, healthcare, pay equality and commuting times, while 'city buzz' considers nightlife, entertainment and cultural offer.
